ExCee Excursion Terms and Conditions

The ExCee Committee

February 14, 2026

Article 1. Definitions

The following definitions hold in these Terms and Conditions:

- a) **Cover:** Study Association Cover;
- b) **ExCee:** The committee of Cover responsible for organizing the excursion;
- c) **The Cover website:** Cover's own website which can be found through the link: <https://www.svcover.nl/>
- d) **Excursion:** The excursion that will take place in the week given in the live year schedule. The live year schedule is leading, and at the time of writing the given date is the week of the 13th of April 2026;
- e) **Participation fee:** The costs of enrollment, services and facilities offered for the excursion;
- f) **Participant:** Person who is enrolled for the excursion;
- g) **Board:** Board of the Study Association Cover.

Article 2. Applicability

- a) These terms and conditions apply to all participants of the excursion of Cover, organized by the ExCee.
- b) Deviations from, and additions to, these terms and conditions are valid if and only if these are made known on the Cover website by the ExCee, or when they are agreed upon in writing between the ExCee together with the Board and the participant(s) in question.

Article 3. Data

- a) The ExCee makes its best effort to guarantee the correctness, completeness, and reliability of the information they provide.
- b) In case of a dispute, the information published on the Cover website will be used as a starting point.
- c) The content of the excursion is determined by the information as published by the ExCee on the Cover website, or other publications of the ExCee. The ExCee cannot be held responsible for any content provided by third parties.
- d) The ExCee will treat the data provided by the participant on the enrollment form in a confidential manner according to Cover's privacy statement, except as stated otherwise in this document.

- e) The ExCee may share participant's data with third parties exclusively for the purpose of organizing the excursion. This includes airline reservations and/or local activities.

Article 4. Enrollment

- a) The agreement between the ExCee, Cover, and the participant is established through enrollment on the Cover website.
- b) The enrollment period is from the 16th of February 2026 at 18:00 Amsterdam Time until the 2nd of March 2026 at 23:59 Amsterdam Time.
- c) Enrollment is completed when confirmation has been received by mail.
- d) Enrollment obliges the participant to pay the participation fee. Personal expenses during the trip are not included. Personal expenses are all expenses made by a participant that are not covered under the services and facilities offered by the ExCee for the excursion.

Article 5. Enrollment Policy

- a) The enrollment will begin on the 16th of February 2026 at 18:00 Amsterdam Time.
- b) Enrollment for the event is on a first-come-first-serve basis for current students of the AI, CS, and/or CCS programmes, with places reserved for the ExCee and one Board member if no Board member is in the ExCee. Once the event reaches 25 enrollments, any additional AI, CS, and/or CCS students will be placed on a waiting list, also on a first-come-first-serve basis. Students who are not enrolled in the AI, CS, and/or CCS programmes will be placed on a separate, second waiting list.

After the sign-up deadline, we will first offer any available spots to students on the AI, CS, and/or CCS waiting list, in order of registration. If spots are still available after this, they will be offered to students on the non-AI, non-CS, and/or non-CCS waiting list, also in order of registration.

This policy ensures that AI, CS, and/or CCS students, as well as ExCee and Board members, have priority in attending the event, while still allowing for additional participation if space permits. Please note that this policy is subject to change at any time, and it is the responsibility of the participant to stay informed about any updates.

- c) The ExCee retains the right to, without given reason, provide or deny people with the right to participate in the excursion.

Article 6. Payment

- a) The final amount consists of the participation fee.
- b) The final amount is up to EUR 450, which will be deducted in 3 rates of up to EUR 150 each, in March, April, and May.
- c) The participant authorises study association Cover (SEPA Creditor Identifier: NL48ZZZ400267070000) to deduct the final amount from the participant's bank account as provided during enrollment.
- d) Cover will send the participant an email at least 3 days in advance to notify them of direct debits.

- e) The final amount debited from the participant is determined by the ExCee in consultation with the Board.

Article 7. Cancellation

- a) If cancellation occurs until the 2nd March at 23:59 Amsterdam Time, the cancellation fee is 20 percent of the costs incurred by the committee up until that moment for the canceling participant. If the ExCee is able to find a replacing participant off of the waiting list, this fee is voided.
- b) If cancellation after the 2nd of March at 23:59 Amsterdam Time occurs before the beginning of the excursion according to the live year schedule, the cancellation fee is 100 percent of the costs incurred by the committee up until that moment. If the ExCee is able to find a replacing participant off of the waiting list, the fee is lowered to all costs associated with replacement, if any.
- c) Cancellation is not possible during the excursion.
- d) Short-term cancellation due to unforeseen circumstances does not remove any obligations from the participant to, after the deadline of enrollment, pay the participant fee.

Article 8. Accountability

- a) The accountability of the ExCee is limited to what is agreed in these terms and conditions.
- b) The ExCee is not accountable for any damages that are the result of:
 - (a) Shortcomings in the implementation of the agreement based on conditions which are attributable to the participant, including damage as a result of the health conditions of the participant.
 - (b) Actions and influences of third parties.
 - (c) Conditions which are not due to the fault of the ExCee and/or, under applicable law, cannot be reasonably attributed on to the ExCee.
- c) The ExCee is not accountable for any damage of the participant due to incorrect or incomplete information provided by the ExCee to the participant.
- d) The ExCee is not accountable for any damage that is directly or indirectly a result of the actions of the participant. Damages caused by the participant leading to costs will be charged to the participant, under applicable law.
- e) The ExCee, after consulting with the Board, reserves the right to impose fines on participants of the trip for any actions that result in a negative image or reputation for the trip, association, or university. The maximum fine imposed is EUR 250.
- f) In the case of misconduct, before or during the excursion, the ExCee, in consultation with the board, is free to exclude the concerning participant(s) from further participation of the excursion. The participant(s) will still be obliged to pay the participation fee to Cover.

Article 9. Alcohol and Drugs

- a) Participants are not allowed to bring alcoholic drinks of their own to the accommodation. Any such drinks shall be confiscated by the ExCee.

- b) The consumption of alcohol under the age of 18 is not allowed. If anyone is found to be in the violation of this rule, the ExCee has the right to remove the participant from the excursion at their own expenses, including any travel costs.
- c) The usage of illicit substances is prohibited. If anyone is found under the influence of any of these substances, the ExCee has the right to remove the participant from the excursion at their own expenses, including any travel costs.
